

**Dignity For All Students Act (DASA)**

The Dignity for All Students Act prohibits harassment and/or discrimination of students by employees or other students on school property or at school functions based upon a student’s actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practice, disability, sexual orientation, gender or sex.

Incidences of bullying and/or harassment should be reported to the school district by completing a Sidney Central School District Bully Prevention Form or Sidney Central School District Complaint Form 3420F (this form is to be used for all complaints within the Sidney Central School District, including incidents of alleged discrimination or harassment.) These forms are located in the guidance office, in each building’s main office, and on the district’s website. Forms can also be accessed online on the Sidney Central School District homepage: [www.sidneycsd.org](http://www.sidneycsd.org). Forms can be deposited into any specified drop boxes in the building or turned into the main office.
